## **KZN Interclub Championship Rules and Race Format**

Riders will represent their clubs in a team pool to earn points for the overall club team.

- 5 riders to make a club team. There are no limitations on age group or class for who makes up your team.
- Team pool can be from any registered club member
- Team pools will remain anonymous to riders, so all riders have to race their hardest because they don't know if they are scoring points or not.
- All riders score points on the same scale (elites don't score additional points)
- Every moto counts riders score points for every moto and final.
- Club Team is automatically selected by Sqorz based on your clubs best 5 riders results.
- Club gets additional 10 points for team pool riders wearing official club race kit.
- Wild card option, each clubs 5 riders will be put in a hat, the other club chairman's will pull a name
  out the hat, that rider will earn double points. Wild card applies to A and B teams. Wildcard
  remains anonymous and draw will be done on completion of final race before the results are
  announced.
- A and B teams are automatically selected by Sqorz from clubs entered riders on the day.
- A and B teams run as separate scoring events i.e. there will be an A Team Trophy and a B Team Trophy. A and B team points are not combined.
- Team A riders need to be expert to score.
- The B teams can be expert or novice and both earn the same points.
- No rider can race for both teams.
- Team pool is set for the duration of the race day. It can only be changed for the next event.
- Team pool riders who don't start due to injury or other reasons can be replaced on the day by a rider who is not part of your B team pool.
- Floating club trophy will be handed out to the leading club for the race meeting. And after the 3<sup>rd</sup> race event the winning club will keep the trophy for the year along with the bragging rights!

- While every effort has been taken to work out the race format and rules, we acknowledge that this is a new race format and the rules may require some adjustment as the series evolves. For this reason, we have allowed rule changes upon agreement of all the club chairmans. Any changes will then be communicated to the clubs via your chairman.
- Any questions or concerns about the rules and race format must be submitted in writing to your club chairman.
